Appearance and Behaviour Acceptance Form

Scout uniform should be worn for Scout meetings - see page 6. Uniform is worn at **all** formal Scout or Scout supported events **unless** otherwise advised. When on outside activities, like hiking, Scouts should expect to wear their scout scarves (neckers) even if other hiking clothing may be recommended for the place and conditions prevailing.

Scouts are expected:

- To attend weekly meetings, arriving on time .
- To enjoy themselves and to have fun.
- To learn to work as a team.
- To listen to each other, Leaders and Visitors and generally to show respect for all, remembering the Scout Promise and Law.
- Not to tolerate bullying, harassment, picking on others or making fun of others and indeed to prevent and report any such behaviour.
- To be silent at times such as flag break and when someone is talking.
- To join in games and activities, to keep to the rules of such games of activities as they may be involved in and to help ensure that games and activities run smoothly.
- If warned about poor behaviour, to correct themselves.

In the event of misbehaviour a verbal warning will be given to the Scout concerned. If a Scout persists in poor behaviour or if it is serious enough, the Scout will probably be removed from the current activity for a short time. If a Scout still continues in bad behaviour then he/she may be taken home or a Parent/Guardian contacted and asked to fetch him/her.

Data Storage, Photographs, Videos & Website Permission Form

We have to hold information on all children in the Scout Group.
